Minutes of Annual Meeting, 01/18/2007

1. Bill Horton – Alleged Embezzlement – questions were answered.
2. What we are doing or propose to do.
 - A. The Bureau of Reclamation has granted us a waiver on the 1000ft. rule. This is their rule, not the EPA. It stated that no range will be within 1000 ft. of any body of water.
 - B. We will have to adhere to rules making our outdoor range handicap accessible. And the bureau still wants us to have a \$100,000 bond against any eventual cleanup.
 - C. Now that we have that waiver on the 1000 ft. rule, we are proposing to go forward with a new 100 yd. rifle range were the trap range is now located. We should be able to put in at least 10 firing points. Then the old rifle range will become the pistol range. Would any of the members like to be part of a group to work on that project.
 - D. The club did get a 50/50 grant from Bureau of Reclamation for improvements to the outdoor range. Total \$25,000, Club comes up with ½.
 - E. We are going to install a sign on the gate to the outdoor range that will have the dates of the clean ups on it. If we want to continue to have the use of the outdoor range we must maintain and clean up what we have.
 - F. To encourage members to come to cleanups we will continue to give away raffle items at the cleanups. Wayne Long has donated some items for the cleanup raffles.
 - G. The membership discussed raising the membership fee.

NO ACTION TAKEN

- H. To encourage members to come to cleanup days the Board and Officers are suggesting that we add a \$20 maintenance fee above the membership fee to start in 2008. Then if a member attended any 1 clean up they would get the fee returned.

THE CLUB VOTED: TO HAVE 6 CLEANUP DAYS AND ADD A \$50.00 FEE TO ANY MEMBER THAT DOES NOT COME TO ONE OF THE 6 CLEANUP DAYS. THIS \$50.00 FEE WILL BE ADDED TO THE MEMBERS NEXT ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP FEE. SO THEIR MEMBERSHIP FEE WOULD BE \$110.00 INSTEAD OF \$60.00 IN 2008.

- J. The gate has been moved. Mr. Cooper called to say the people who rent his cabins were tired of opening & closing the gate. So would we mind if he moved down the road. We immediately said OK and even volunteered help, but he did the entire project himself.
- K. We want to raise the per day use fee for the indoor range from \$0.50 to \$1.00 to help cover the cost of propane to heat the indoor range in the winter.

THE CLUB VOTED: TO RAISE THE INDOOR RANGE FEE TO \$1.00 PER USE.

L. We (Officers & Board) put in place a use fee for those organizations who want to use either of our ranges: \$10 per person per day for the indoor range and \$5.00 per person per day for the outdoor range. We also require that the people who want to use the range either become members of the Club so they are covered under our insurance or provide proof of liability insurance, \$1,000,000 minimum.

THE CLUB OK'D THESE FEES, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF HUNTER SAFETY CLASSES, THEY WILL ONLY HAVE TO PAY \$5.00 PER PERSON FOR USING THE INDOOR RANGE.
