

Estes Park Gun and Archery Club  
Annual Membership Meeting Minutes  
January 16, 2014

Gordon Ulrickson, President-Called meeting to order, 7:00PM, Rocky Mountain Park Inn, Estes Park. Gordon led the Pledge of Allegiance and offered a Moment of Silence for members passed this year.

Colorado Mounted Rangers – Update on activities and made a request for volunteers.

Sheriff Justin Smith – Main speaker addressed the following:

- Update on gun legislation in Colorado (now the court case challenges are being handled by Colorado Shooting Sports organization)
- Impressed by Estes Park area residents resiliency to September flood
- Talked about magazine limitations
- CCP changes so that a renewal involving a county to county move can be an easier process (rather than starting from scratch)
- Finally addressed Q & A from the audience.

Treasurer's report was given by Patty Eldridge of P & L accounts.

Membership update from Bob Mitchiner – Main point is that there is a 600 member cap.

Rick Tekulve talked about clean-up committee and solicited for work leader and sign-in people for the 2014 days.

Gordon delivered the new business –EVRPD now owns the “Common Point” range and that EPGAC is working with EVRPD as a concessionaire. New contract is 14 pages longer than the old one and is for 10 years with (2) 5 year extensions possible. Still needing to pay EVRPD a 10% fee from gross revenues.

The status of the “Common Point” road was the next topic of discussion. The first stage is to repair the Noel's Draw Bridge (offUS-34) so that equipment can access the rest of the project. The remains of the rifle range may be used as road base and will lower the rifle range to the level of the pistol range.

In order for compliance with the new contract (per public access requirements) there may need to be “Common Point” sign in by both members and guests.

Finally, the last order of business was club elections. Mike Sand announced his candidacy for board director at large. Gordon Ulrickson, President; Noah (Nick) England, 1<sup>st</sup> VP; Randy Buchanan, 2<sup>nd</sup> VP; William (Bill) Howell, Secretary; Treasurer office open; Mike Sand, 3 yr. term Director; Rick Tekulve, 1 yr. term Director; Doug Tabor, 2 yr. term Director; election proceeded with slate of officers and unanimously voted as new Board of Directors. Steve Murphree is fulfilling his two year term and Patty Eldridge will continue to provide financial records until her replacement has been selected.

Although out of agenda order, Robert Hintz and Dave O'Farrell volunteered to be the Financial Review committee for the Club account records.
