

Estes Park Gun & Archery Club
Board Meeting April 12, 2010
Minutes

The Estes Park Gun & Archery Club Board held their monthly meeting at Re/Max Mountain Brokers conference room, April 12, 2010. Board members present were, Sharyn Gartner, David Engelhardt, Patty Eldridge, Steven Shyrock, Jim Wilson, Bill Conger and Ward Brien. Absent members, Paul Kuna and Peter McGillivray, were excused. Sgt Robert Schumaker, LEA Representative, was invited but not present.

The meeting convened at 1900 with a call to order and approval of presented agenda. Previous meeting minutes were approved as submitted.

Report of Officers started with Sharyn noting that RMNP, Jim Sanborn, Law Enforcement Specialist requested May 18th use of Outdoor range, 11:00 to 9:00pm with full closure.

Shot Barrier Curtain project Structural Engineer, John Spooner & Architect, Jerry Miller will need dug soil sample testing done to complete the engineered drawings.

The cost of digging by Kitchen & Company is estimated at \$400 and the soil test report & drawings could run another \$1,000. This portion of the project will not be covered by the DOW Grant but is needed to submit to Larimer County Building Department for permit. A meeting is planned for digging location & cost options with Mr. Spooner & Mr. Miller.

The Club received a recent billing estimate from Kitchen & Company for road maintenance of Noels Draw Lane, \$4005.00. Sharyn will be meeting with EVRPD to share half the cost.

Sharyn received call from Army out of Colorado Springs, inquiring about outdoor range use for mountain terrain training. She will wait for them to contact again to visit range before any decision is made besides suggesting they visit Buffalo Creek Gun Club near Bailey, CO.

Dave Engelhardt presented wood framed storage sheds by Shaffer's, Drake, pricing from 1,299 to 1,599 built on site. The size most board members liked was the 10X12 either 9 or 11 foot elevation. The location at the Outdoor Range is still in discussion. Ward Brien suggested contacting places with Coastal Used Pods for pricing/delivery.

Treasurer, Patty Eldridge, presented March Profit & Loss statement. Income \$2,075.60 and Expense \$7,742.29 net being \$-5,666.69 with ending Bank Statement balance for March 31st, as \$37,123.15. For April, expenses paid: Van Horn Engineering site plan survey copies of \$58.50, Polar Gas (propane for Indoor Range) \$263.50 and to our webmaster, Jeff Van Bogaert, \$29.94 (6 month fee for website).

Committee reports from Bill Conger, Grants, said that DOW has been slow to respond. Bill also filled out Survey of Future Projects for GOCO. He submitted plans for lowering the Rifle Range and installing a year round restroom close to the Indoor Range (\$100,000 each).

Political/Legal Issues, Jim Wilson noted the competition between Carl Brenning and Justin Smith for Sheriff is Larimer County's ballot issue. Jim will notify us of any candidate debates scheduling.

Indoor Range clean-up scheduled for April 17th, 10 to 1:00. No word as to the planned time frame from David Bruce on the backstop welding repairs at the Indoor Range.

Steven Shyrock presented a preliminary map of the Outdoor Range to help new members become oriented to the different range locations. Updated map will be shown at May 10th meeting.

No further business was presented and meeting adjourned at 2010.
