**Douglas Tabor, Secretary**

Report: Published in agenda, including indoor range use totals.

Committee Reports

Membership report by Gordon – 444 members, 103 new members, 20 life renewed, 321 annual renewals (2 on hold, not in totals) + 7 envelopes. [475 potentially with unprocessed applications]

**Sharyn Gartner, Shot Barrier Curtain** – report emailed. If curtain hanging is photographed from bucket truck, it can go into a manual for assembly. Use 3” aluminum carabiner at 98 cents, instead of steel at \$4. Rick asked about largest trap shot size (7½ by Nick).

**Rick Tekulve, Clean up Committee** report – Rick Tekulve presented Tom's leader/coordinator lists. Needs for clean up events – respirator masks, Tyvek suits and sprayer to wet down dirt. Open a dialog Sam Barnett – would fund painting of indoor range floor and find people to do labor. He will also like a space to lock up his targets. Comment about 1/2” holes in brass buckets – need smaller holes for 22 shells. Nick put out new buckets with smaller holes. Bill asked about duties and tools used for clean ups. Make sure these duties are clear. Janie no longer with DOW but has a heavy, large locker at the indoor range. Battery needs to be changed in mower before clean up season.

Unfinished business

Port-a-let from Waste Management went up in price. EVPRD will be funding half of this expense. BSA has officially blessed indoor range and Gordon is now certified merit badge instructor.

New business

Bill Howell (on behalf of Larimer county Republican party) fund raising event to have 2<sup>nd</sup> amendment day at outdoor range – investigating a private event.

Range wind speed policy – anemometer?

Range target stands – Nick is pursuing more designs and bids for the rifle range target stands.

Prioritization of goals to match budget. Road reconstruction. Gordon asked for suggestions of project goals. Camera to capture who is doing damage to outdoor range. Both tabled until next meeting.
