Gordon - President actions

New Business**1. Gordon**

1. Range cleanup - as discussed in Rick's report.
2. Membership renewals - (and a note needs to go to Bob about this for renewal letter) - Renewals are still on as normal with a goal of having NO renewals at the annual membership meeting (date: 1/16/2014 @ Estes Park Convention Center.) The letter (and website) needs to call out the status of the 2 ranges. The letter should also mention that though there may be less "access" to the ranges, that the membership limit of 600 is currently 5 away (after the last class was held at the indoor range), and that a non-renewal will jeopardize a members' position within that limit.
3. Opening Indoor Range for more availability.
 1. Suggested weekend dates (when regularly scheduled classes are held, move date to Sunday)
 2. Suggested lunch date - Scott volunteered to be RO for a lunch date
 3. Need to firm these days -AND- publish in newsletter AND on the website
 4. Suggested to find a OSHA engineer to view ventilation compliance. When shooting is 1 hour/day, this should not be an issue.
 5. Also suggested that additional indoor range cleanups are done (monthly?) with the increased usage of the range.
4. Motion was made, seconded and carried to start a committee to begin search for a new, independently owned property for an outdoor range. Steve mentioned, if it were needed, that the poles for the shot barrier curtain would be re-purchased by the original vendor.
5. Attendance at the 10/24 meeting of the EVPRD board by members of EPGAC was suggested. But to be on the agenda, a request must be filed this week.
