Common Point Range Shelters

Ground has been broken on the range shelters. We are waiting for a Setback certification (concerns the required distance back from the property line, road easement and stream bed) before the foundations for the posts can be poured. Holes have been dug. In the meantime, please use the tactical range at the top of the property (in the trap range area) for all your pistol and rifle shooting. The pistol and rifle ranges are closed until construction is finished on the shelters.

Sunday Indoor Range Hours

In case you didn't notice it, we added Sunday public hours to the indoor range schedule from 2 PM to 3 PM. These hours should remain in effect until the Saturday public days resume at the outdoor range, on June 1st.

Clean-Up Dates On Membership Cards

Some of the membership cards that went out have the wrong dates on the back for the Outdoor Range clean up dates only. The Indoor Range dates should be fine. The correct dates are on the club's calendar at www.epgunarchery.com. For the incorrect cards, the day of the week and the date will not match. In other words, if it says Saturday May 19th on it, it is incorrect. May 19th is a Sunday. The correct date is Saturday May 18th. Generally, the day of the week is correct, the stated date following it may be incorrect. If you are off on one, you are off on all the dates and you have one of the incorrect cards. Hopefully, there were only a few incorrect cards sent – we can't track down who received correct cards versus incorrect ones. If you have any questions, the correct dates are posted on the website, please review them there.
