Excerpt from the Club By-Laws

“Article VII- Duties of Officers

President: The President shall preside at all meetings of the club and of the Board of Directors. He/she shall be a member ex-officio of all regular and special committees, and shall perform all such other duties as usually pertain to his office.”

If the current President wishes to run for another term and has not been elected for this office, 3 years consecutively, he/she places their name on the ballot for election at the Annual Meeting. If the current President does not wish to serve another year or is term limited, he/she will automatically be placed on the Board as the immediate past president for a term of one year. (The past president is considered an advisory to keep current projects forthcoming and help new Directors understand past policies and goals of the club.)

1. Stays in contact with all officers.
2. Member ex-officio of all committees
3. Main contact with landlord, Estes Valley Recreation & Park District (EVRPD)
 - A. Grant Requests
 - B. Submits Budget request to EVRPD Director
4. Attends Board Meetings of the EVRPD once a month w/reports as requested
5. Oversees EVRPD & Gun Club Contract
6. Presides over Annual & Board meetings (Robert’s Rules of Order/ Club’s By-Law knowledge)
7. Keeps in contact with LEA groups
8. Always a main contact with club members
9. Reviews Annual and Board minutes before presentation
10. Works with Treasurer on Annual Financial Reports & Proposed Annual Budget
11. Retains past club files and history
12. Beginning of the year -sets proposed projects and goals for the year
13. NRA member
14. Active with Cleanup Days at Outdoor & Indoor ranges
15. Presents a President’s Report to the Board monthly
