Items for the meeting -

- What came out of the meeting with the people from Berthoud about the trap poles? Standby while Berthoud's site does environmental drill.
- Ken wants to use clay targets in holders above the plate rack, possibly only at supervised events - discussion? SC proposed affirmative, 2nd' and passed unanimously.
- Did Michael Ferrante ever get paid for the \$475 invoice for additional road work at and above the tac field entrance?
- Are we ready to push ahead for bids on removing the trap poles?
Tabled until Berthoud results.
- Do we want to move ahead with storage (shed or shipping container) for the lower ranges? Tabled, maintaining for ongoing consideration.
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- Do we need to talk about range scheduling policies? We've had this pop up a few times recently. Current policies are that we are not a for rent or a for reservation facility. That's for members or non-members. Exceptions are local law enforcement agencies, competitions, instructor lead shooting/safety classes, and non-profit organization events. Those last 2 are possible, but not mandatory. We have had mixed results with

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those and are free to decline based on timing of the events or our desire to host or not host.

- **Defining terminology/ Developing criteria**

Ken Rihanek gave me \$105 in cash from the April Steel shoot

He also gave me receipts (attached) and a **request for reimbursement for \$31.37** for a large trash can to store 1x2s in for the steel range shoots (includes IDPA style shoots as well).

I am requesting reimbursement for \$164.53 (receipts attached) for paint, caulk, 1x2s, sign hardware, gas for recycle trip (1st time), mortar tubs for brass sorting, squeegee, stakes and clamps for target stands.

I took our brass to Commerce City and we got \$5252.80 for 1340 lbs of brass and \$13.20 for a couple of buckets of steel cases and a few lbs of aluminum cases. I'll have a check for the brass and cash for the steel and aluminum. That was 260 lbs less brass than we had last time, but they paid us a higher price. We also had about 350 lbs of lead and some misc copper and stuff that added to the total for last time, but we made more this time due to the higher prices.

We had a work day on Thursday with 16 participants and got a lot done. Range looks really good, mowed and trimmed. Pistol shed door caulked and painted, bathroom cleaned, steel painted, stands repaired, brass sorted.
